

The Patient Consent Registration Tab


Clicking on the Tab - will bring you to the Patient Search function within the Hosted Registration tool.

Depending on your role, you may have access to additional tabs in the Clinical viewer, or you may see only this one tab.



To Edit or Add Patient Consent

Click on the patient/consent registration tab and you will see a patient search. Your organization's name will already be pre-populated. If your organization has multiple locations, you will have the option to select a particular site from a pull-down menu.



Two Options to Search a Patient

To find the patient in the Healthix System, you have two options – Search by Medical Record Number (MRN) or by Demographics. If you use a demographic search use the patient's last name and two other demographic characteristics like date of birth, zip code or phone number

Medical Record Number Search

In this Example we will use the Patient MRN –and click to search

This will bring up the patient name– Click on the Blue Link labeled Select Patient. *(as seen in image to right)*

This takes you to the Patient Consent Screen

Patient Consent Registration

Here you can edit any of the demographic fields as well as the consent decisions. For the consent type - **Select from the pull down menu** which shows four consent options:

- Emergency Only
- Yes – Give Consent
- No – Deny Consent
- No Consent Status Given (this is the same as the Undecided status)

After selecting the consent status that the patient has selected on the Healthix Consent Form.

Enter the Date of Consent. (This date must match the date on the consent form and is a mandatory field).

Then Hit Save.

NOTE: A copy of the Healthix patient consent form, either scanned or in paper form, must be kept and easily retrieved for auditing purposes. It must be fully completed with the patient's consent choice, their birth date, date of the consent and their signature.

Select Patient's Consent Decision

Once you have finished the demographic information you will select the patient's Consent decision. Some organizations may have the option of selecting Facility based consent or Community Based Consent.

Again you will enter the consent status, then the date of consent and Hit Save.

Possible consent values include:

- Yes - Give Consent to Community / Facility
- No - Deny Consent to Community / Facility
- No Consent Value - Patient does not specify any consent decision

Healthix Registration ID

This time the system will generate a Healthix Registration ID for this new patient. You can use this in the future to update any future changes in consent.
