



Healthix Query enables search and retrieval of longitudinal patient history and information. Healthix data is updated in real time with each patient encounter. Healthix consent is required to access patient health information.

Data in the Healthix Portal

Patient data is aggregated from across a variety of provider types, from hospitals to physician practices to labs and more. Healthix holds data on over 20 million patients from the greater New York region. To view a list of organizations contributing data and the data they provide, visit our [online directory](#).

Data within the Portal can be accessed through a series of tabs (shown on the left-side menu of the screen shot) or through the patient summary filter that allows you to refine your search by date range and information type.

Accessing the Portal

Web Enabled Log In: You can access the Healthix Portal by going to <https://portal.healthix.org> and entering your username, password and a text-based numeric code sent to your mobile device.

Single Sign On (SSO) Access: Organizations can arrange for users' to access the Portal through a SSO connection within their EHR. Users' internal EHR credentials will authenticate their access, and the patient search will initiate the search within the Portal. The experience, once in the Portal, remains identical for both user types.



Side Menu Shows Data Available

Patient Search allows you to seek a patient by their medical record number or their demographic information. There are several ways to search for your patient in the Healthix Portal.

Retrieving information via patient record look-up, the Healthix Portal, CCD or CCDA requests.

EHR Integration

Participants within Healthix are both users and contributors of data. The initial integration is done in one of two ways.

1. Hub Model – Healthix connects to the EHR’s Hub to exchange data with multiple practices. Hub models dramatically reduce time, cost and effort. There is no charge for hub model integration. 2. Conventional Integration (Non-Hub) – This is a customized connection requiring a detailed scope of work and technical resource allocation. Pricing will be based on time and materials.

- The patient summary tab quickly allows for filtering specifically on the data you wish to review and creating a CCD or PDF.
